Smoky Slate Card stock: Cut 8 ½" x 5 ½"; scored at 4 ¼"

Basic Gray Card stock: Cut 3 3/4" x 5"

Country Lace Designer Series Paper: Cut (3) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Basic Gray Card stock: Cut 2 3/4" x 3 1/4" Basic White Card stock: Cut 2 3/4" x 3 1/4" Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Basic Gray & Smoky Slate Pearls: 5-7 assorted

Assembly:

- 1. Stamp the sentiment onto Basic White Card stock using Smoky Slate Classic Ink.
- 2. Then stamp the sentiment onto Basic White Card stock using Basic Gray Classic Ink moving it slightly to create the shadow effect.
- 3. Cut the sentiment out using the Nested Essentials Die and your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
- 4. Cut a coordinating label shape using the Basic Gray card stock and the Stampin' Cut and Emboss.
- 5. Adhere the strips of Country Lace Designer Series Paper to the Basic Gray Card stock panel. (Make sure they go in order)
- 6. Adhere the layered panel to the card front.
- 7. Adhere the sentiment to the Basic Gray Label.
- 8. Adhere the label to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Add 5-7 of the Pearls using your Take Your Pick Tool to the around the card front and sentiment panel.
- 10. Stamp the inside sentiment panel using Basic Gray Classic Ink if desired.
- 11. Adhere the inside stamped panel to the inside of the card.
- 12. Decorate your Basic White Envelope as desired.
