Assembly:

- 1. Stamp the wings and antennas using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto Basic White Card stock.
- 2. Stamp the Bee's body using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto Daffodil Delight card stock.
- 3. Punch out the wings, antennas, and bee using the Bee Builder Punch.
- 4. Then using Memento Tuxedo black Ink stamp the bee's face as desired.
- 5. Assemble the Bee by placing a bit of adhesive to the point on the wings and antennas.
- 6. Score Designer Series Paper as shown with the shorter edge along the top.
- 7. To assemble add Tear & Tape along the long edge of the Designer Series Paper. Remove protective strip and wrap around the candy as shown, adhere.
- 8. Add some adhesive to the back of the bee and attach it to the front of the wrapped chocolate as desired.
- 9. Give the sweet treat to someone special!
