

## Friendly Seagulls Friend Card Tutorial



### Paper

Early Espresso Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Country Woods Designer Series Paper: Cut 5 3/4" x 4"

Early Espresso Card stock: 4" x 2 1/2"

Country Woods Designer Series Paper: Cut 3 3/4" x 2 1/4"

Early Espresso Card stock: Cut (3) 1 3/8" x 2"

Basic White Card stock: Cut (3) 1 1/8" x 1 3/4"

Country Woods designer Series Paper: Cut 2 1/4" x 1/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 3" x 1/2"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

### Assembly:

1. Stamp the sentiment on strip of Basic White card stock strip using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad.
2. Stamp each of the seagull images using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad on 3 Basic White Card stock panels.
3. Using the Gray Granite, Crumb Cake, and Peach Pie Stampin' Blends to color the seagulls as shown.
4. Using Pool Party Stampin' Blends outline the 3 seagulls.
5. Adhere the 3 seagull panels to the 3 Early Espresso Card stock panels.
6. Adhere the Designer Series Paper to the card front.
7. Then adhere the Designer Series Paper to the other Early Espresso panel.
8. Adhere the layered panel to the card front as shown.
9. Using Stampin' Dimensionals adhere the last seagull panel to the layered panel on the card front in the center as shown.
10. Then using Stampin' Dimensionals adhere the 2 seagull panels to the right and left side of the first seagull on the card front. They will extend out over the card front about ¼".
11. Using your Paper Snips cut the left end of the sentiment strip into a banner.
12. Then cut the ends of the small strip of Designer Series Paper at an angle on both the left and right sides.
13. Adhere the sentiment onto the Designer Series Paper strip centering it.
14. Adhere the sentiment panel to the center of the seagull panels.
15. Stamp the inside as desired.
16. Stamp envelope as desired.
