

## Friendly Fins Half Hexagon Pop Up Card Tutorial



### Paper

Gray Granite Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 4 1/4"; scored at 3/4" and 4 3/4"  
Gray Granite Card stock: Cut (2) 3/4" x 7"; scored at 3/4", 2 1/2", and 4 1/2"  
Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 5 3/4"; cut at 1/2" off each end  
Basic White Card stock: Cut (2) 3/4" x 4 3/4"  
Real Red Card stock: scrap for die cutting  
Calypso Coral Card stock: scrap for die cutting  
Crumb Cake Card stock: scrap for die cutting  
Petal Pink Card stock: scrap for die cutting  
Summer Splash Card stock: scrap for die cutting  
Basic White Card stock: Cut 3 3/4" x 4"  
Basic White Card stock: piece for die cutting  
Window Sheet: 1/2" x 4"

## Friendly Fins Half Hexagon Pop Up Card Tutorial

1. Stamp the 2 dolphin outline images onto Basic White Card stock using Gray Granite Classic Ink.
2. Then stamp off and add the 2-step dolphin inside image using Gray Granite Classic Ink.
3. Die cut out the dolphins using the coordinating dies and Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
4. Using the dies cut out the 2 large and 2 small rocks using Crumb Cake Card stock, the lobster using Real Red Card stock, 3 fish and shell using Calypso Coral Card stock, Reef using Petal Pink Card stock and 6 long coral using Summer Splash Card stock. Set aside.
5. Using your Blending Brush and Summer Splash Classic Ink add color the Basic White Card stock panel as shown. Then add Crumb Cake to the bottom of the panel.
6. Cut ½" from each end of the panel and adhere to the card base.
7. Using your Blending Brush and Summer Splash Classic Ink add color the Basic White Card strip as shown. Then add Crumb Cake to the other strip.
8. Cut the strips from each end at 1 ½". Keep in the right order and adhere to the strips of Gray Granite Card stock that have been scored.
9. Adhere the coral piece onto the panel.
10. Then adhere the 3 small fish below the coral.
11. Adhere the coral and rocks to the right and left of the reef as shown. You may need to cut if it runs across the score lines.
12. Add the dolphin to the panel using Stampin' Dimensionals.
13. To create the floating dolphin, use a couple of Mini Glue Dots and adhere the strip to the left of the center panel strip on the backside.
14. Lay the long strips for the top on the flat card base and score/fold them around to the back. Adhere one side down on the back and then adhere the second side down making sure the card will lie flat.

Continued:

15. Repeat for the bottom strip.
16. Using Mini Glue Dots adhere the second dolphin as desired to the Window Sheet strip.
17. For the back stamp signature panel as desired and adhere to the back side. To hide the tabs on the back you can create another set of ½" x 4" strips of Basic White card stock that has been blended on with Summer Splay and Crumb Cake to look like the front side to cover the tabs from the top and bottom Pop-Up panels.
18. Stamp envelope as desired.
