Basic White Thick Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Petunia Pop Card stock: Cut 1 1/4" x 5 1/4"

Secret Sea Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 1/2"

Floral Impressions Designer Series Paper: Cut 5 1/4" x 2 3/4"

Basic White Card stock: piece for punching

Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Strawberry Slush & Pretty in Pink Gems (Clear): 3-5 assorted sizes

Assembly:

1. Stamp the sentiment onto Basic White Card stock panel using Secret Sea Classic Ink.
2. Then stamp the flower using Strawberry Slush Classic Ink. Stamping off for the two-step image.
3. Punch sentiment out using the Heartfelt Hexagon Punch.
4. Adhere the Petunia Pop card stock strip to the card front along the bottom.
5. Adhere the strip of Secret Sea to the panel of Designer Series Paper on the bottom as shown.
6. Then adhere the layered panel onto the card front on the top.
7. Then using Stampin' Dimensionals add the sentiment hexagon to the card front as shown.
8. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add 3-5 Gems to the card front as desired.
9. Stamp the inside panel as desired. (I used Stamp sentiment onto inside panel using Secret Sea Classic Ink. Then stamp the flower using Strawberry Slush and Shy Shamrock Classic Inks. Stamping off for the two step images.)
10. Stamp envelope as desired.
